Mr. Reed has over 35 years of municipal government administrative experience in Virginia and Pennsylvania and an additional nine years experience with Pennsylvania American Water Company, a private water and sewer company, and currently serves as Manager of Major Customer Accounts. During his career, he obtained extensive experience in governmental administration and local and regional land-use planning; financial budgeting and administration; water and wastewater operations; planning and administration; water resources planning and implementation; and in local, regional, state and federal intergovernmental planning and cooperation.

CAREER HISTORY

Beginning in 1966, Mr. Reed entered municipal government administration as Assistant City Manager in Winchester, VA. Thereafter he served as Town/City Manager in Virginia in Strasburg, Purcellville, Buena Vista and Franklin until becoming City Manager in Coatesville, PA in 1987. In 1991 he became Executive Director of the City of Coatesville Authority ("CCA") and was instrumental in assisting in the sale of the CCA assets in 2001 to the Pennsylvania American Water Company ("PAWC") which netted the City over \$39 million. Mr. Reed accepted the position of Manager of the Coatesville District for PAWC. Thereafter Mr. Reed has served PAWC as Business Development Manager and currently serves as Manager of Major Customer Accounts in the Coatesville District.
