The PennCPR Agenda

Cut politicians' perks:

- Reduce Representatives' monthly expense allowance.
- Eliminate incidental perks including complimentary meals, beverages, shoe-shines and haircuts.
- Eliminate state funded vehicle insurance and state reimbursement for rental cars for Representatives. Reduce Representatives' travel allowance by half.
- Equate Representatives' health insurance premiums with those of other government employees.
- Ban all bonuses for state government employees.
- Require full transparency of all caucus accounts, including leadership accounts.

Crack down on lobbyists' influence:

- All employees of businesses who received no-bid contracts must report all political contributions for the preceding year.
- Professional lobbyists must register with a public database, as well as report all their expenses online.
- A no-exception ban on all gifts, trips and other swag from lobbyists.

Bring transparency to campaign funding:

- Require that Representatives must declare if any immediate family member is associated with a gambling entity or publicly funded charity.
- Post all Representative office expense reports and budgets online.
- Require that transfers of money between political committees be reported within 24 hours.
